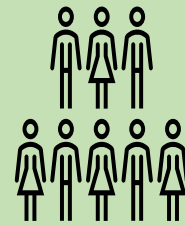


All Healthcare Inequalities Innovation Fund projects supported by ICB health inequalities monies

A project to appoint a clinical lead for the Back to Health pathway supporting people on waiting lists, understanding DNAs and after discharge to reduce readmittance, working with volunteers and VCSE partners to ensure a clinical focus is embedded in the pathways.

Based in George Elliott Hospital and focussed on the Core20 groups



CORE20

An action research initiative to look at improving equity of access community diagnostics centres, starting in Warwickshire North with GEH and looking to include Coventry and Rugby



A joint project between Public Health Warwickshire, Public Health Coventry, Healthwatch and Coventry University

CORE20

Improve outcomes for the Core20PLUS5 population through a Healthy Hospitals approach, focussing on missed appointments, active waiting, Health Equity Assessments and Making Every Contact Count

This project will be run in UHCW with a robust evaluation to follow to ensure learning is captured and shared.



CORE20

System-wide implementation of a health inequalities elective prioritisation tool developed by UHCW. The tool utilises a range of socio-economic, clinical and access waiting time positions.



This tool is currently being piloted within UHCW and is planned to be rolled out across all waiting lists.

Support for the tobacco dependence treatment services, extending services to 7 days a week including prescriptions and covering inpatients, maternity, and community services.

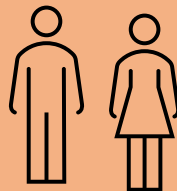
The service is system-wide and will positively impact on the Core20 groups as well as all 5 clinical areas.

Two system-wide roles to establish robust pathways for homeless people attending hospital, focussing on improving discharge, joined up services and training staff to embed knowledge.

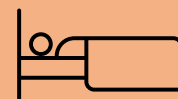


This project will work across all Trusts to improve support for homeless people, one of the Plus groups.

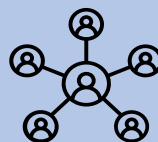
Taking a personalised approach to treat persistent back pain for working aged people in a highly deprived area of Coventry.

This pilot project will work in the Coventry Central PCN, with the aim of rolling out the service to wider stakeholders.



PLUS

A one-year pilot for a team to increase the uptake of cancer screening among people with learning disabilities, autism and severe mental illness. Working with experts by experience to identify and overcome barriers.



CWPT will work with experts by experience in the area evidenced to have the highest deprivation and lowest screening rates

A project to improve digital inclusion and literacy across Coventry, focusing on the development of digital health pilots in partnership with local residents and community partners.



Coventry City Council Digital Transformation team to oversee the project.

Improving maternity continuity of care and early access for women who experience ethnic health inequalities, including vulnerable and deprived groups through VSCE-provided ante and postnatal services including co-produced antenatal pathways for newly arrived families, a transport intervention pilot and culturally appropriate public health messaging.

The project will focus on the Nuneaton & Bedworth area using third sector specialist services.

Health access for refugees programme, based in Coventry but sharing learning with colleagues in Warwickshire.



Taking a personalised care approach to use community assets to support health needs of refugees and asylum seekers

Interventions to address barriers to healthcare experienced by those with respiratory conditions in Lillington, South Warwickshire.

The funding will cover the role of Community Connector to ensure community engagement.

Taking a population health management approach to develop a community-based pathway for managing diabetes. Based in a deprived area of Coventry.



Building on the work already done by Sowe Valley PCN during the wave 3 PHM programme.

A health justice partnership approach, co-locating social welfare advisers in GP practices in areas of deprivation, helping to free up GP time from non-healthcare issues.

The project will start with one PCN in Coventry and aim to develop to a further Coventry PCN and one in Nuneaton.

Produce bespoke, locally co-produced health information for cohort discharged from UHCW who live in most deprived 20% areas.



Working with Cognitant to produce information for people from deprived backgrounds who are at highest risk at discharge, with increased readmission and mortality.

Physical health checks for people with severe mental illness

Strengthening existing commissioned provision, quality improvement and revised approach model. Covers Coventry & Warwickshire

Funding to underpin prescribing of alternative inhalers (staff training and patient education) for Warwickshire North.



The new inhaler will have a reduced carbon footprint and education will be provided to patients as studies show inhaler technique is incorrect with 50% of patients.

Coventry Care Collaborative:

Improving outcomes in urgent care through provision of Social Prescribers for the Coventry Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC).

To work with high frequency users of the UTC who often present with issues which are non-clinical and require alternative support or signposting.

Develop a community-based respiratory management and diagnostics clinic for drug and alcohol service users, tackling the leading cause of death for service users.



The service will be in Coventry, led by CGL with the involvement of UHCW and the Healthy Lifestyles Service.

Improving health outcomes through community-led intervention, taking a hyperlocal approach to health and wellbeing to develop a replicable approach.

This project will work in two of the most deprived areas in Coventry – Foleshill and Willenhall.

Developing a personalised approach to support children and young people to engage and manage diabetes as they transition into adult services.

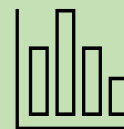


This project will employ a specialist Youth Worker to support children from ages 12-19 in Coventry and Rugby, accessing services at UHCW.

Provision of a data segmentation and analytical tool, Acorn, to support understanding the population accessing urgent and emergency health care services with the aim of reducing or preventing this need through early intervention.

This tool will be used within Coventry to enhance work already underway within the Local Authority

Educational video for PHM pilot for people of working age with persistent back pain, building on the existing MSK project, and enhancing the series of self-care resources to manage the condition.



A Coventry based project which will translate resources into British Sign Language as well as most spoken languages in Coventry.

Warwickshire Care Collaborative

Dedicated Vaccination Midwife to lead the development of an enhanced service model focused on increasing vaccination rates for pregnant women in North Warwickshire, by enabling easier access to vaccination appointments.



The service model will include a community-based model and increased access at GEH, co-produced with identified population groups with low take up rates

Use of a digital platform for GPs and an app for patients, VISO Hypertension Plus, in the management of hypertension, providing personalised care.

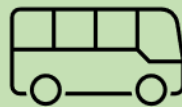
Part of the wider programme in North Warwickshire to tackle health inequalities through CVD case finding.

Mobile community clinic to support community access to a CVD secondary prevention heart failure service, supporting improving outcomes for patients.



Clinics will be held across North Warwickshire, targeting areas of deprivation.

Enhanced physical health checks for UK armed forces veterans, supporting the identification of a range of health conditions, access to appropriate lifestyle interventions and provide peer support for veterans to engage with health services.

This will be provided for veterans in Nuneaton & Bedworth and North Warwickshire, in partnership with a range of veterans charities.

A GP outreach clinic which aims to increase access to primary care services for people experiencing homelessness and other vulnerable transient groups.



This clinic is based in Leamington Spa and uses community settings to bring together relevant services as well as primary care.

To develop a Social Value Charter for Coventry & Warwickshire ICS, along with working towards the Bronze level of a new Social Value Health Award.

To maximise the benefits to the organisation and the community, that can be achieved through social value as an Anchor Institution,

Health inequalities programmes utilising other funding sources

Funding source: Innovation for Health Inequalities Programme (InHIP)

To develop a case finding outreach programme model to opportunistically case find Atrial Fibrillation (AF), hypertension and high cholesterol in the community, stage 1 of the CVD prevention programme in North Warwickshire.

In partnership with primary care networks targeting harder to engage population groups including rural/urban areas and transient communities.

Funding source: Further and Faster

To develop a diagnosis, confirmation and management pathway, using initiatives that accelerate prevention to reduce emergency hospital admissions due to CVD. Includes additional capacity in the follow up pathways and clinics from stage 1 (case identification) of the CVD prevention programme in North Warwickshire.



In partnership with primary care networks, supporting the ongoing management of individuals detected and systematic audits of at-risk population groups

Funding source: NHSE Health Inequalities Improvement funding

Development of training designed to improve the capturing and recording of patient ethnicity details within healthcare services. The training will equip staff with knowledge and understanding of the importance of this data, and the confidence to ask patients for this information.



Initially delivered as a pilot to an acute provider to evaluate training impact. Training has been designed based on findings from the Race Equality Foundation report, 'Improving the recording of ethnicity in health data sets'.
