


Overview of health care health inequalities innovation supported by health inequalities monies

A project to appoint a clinical lead for the Back to Health pathway supporting people on waiting lists, understanding DNAs and after discharge to reduce readmittance, working with volunteers and VCSE partners to ensure a clinical focus is embedded in the pathways.

Based in George Elliot Hospital and focussed on the Core20 groups



CORE20

An action research initiative to look at improving equity of access community diagnostics centres, starting in Warwickshire North with GEH and looking to include Coventry and Rugby



A joint project between Public Health Warwickshire, Public Health Coventry, Healthwatch and Coventry University

CORE20

Improve outcomes for the Core20PLUS5 population through a Healthy Hospitals approach, focussing on missed appointments, active waiting, Health Equity Assessments and Making Every Contact Count

This project will be run in UHCW with a robust evaluation to follow to ensure learning is captured and shared



CORE20

System-wide implementation of a health inequalities elective prioritisation tool developed by UHCW. The tool utilises a range of socio-economic, clinical and access waiting time positions



This tool is currently being piloted within UHCW and is planned to be rolled out across all waiting lists

CORE20

Support for the tobacco dependence treatment services, extending services to 7 days a week including prescriptions and covering inpatients, maternity, and community services


The service is system-wide and will positively impact on the Core20 groups as well as all 5 clinical areas.

5

Two system-wide roles to establish robust pathways for homeless people attending hospital, focussing on improving discharge, joined up services and training staff to embed knowledge




This project will work across all Trusts to improve support for homeless people, one of the Plus groups

PLUS

Taking a personalised approach to treat persistent back pain for working aged people in a highly deprived area of Coventry

This pilot project will work in the Coventry Central PCN, with the aim of rolling out the service to wider stakeholders



PLUS

A one-year pilot for a team to increase the uptake of cancer screening among people with learning disabilities, autism and severe mental illness. Working with experts by experience to identify and overcome barriers



CWPT will work with experts by experience in the area evidenced to have the highest deprivation and lowest screening rates

A project to improve digital inclusion and literacy across Coventry, focusing on the development of digital health pilots in partnership with local residents and community partners.



Coventry City Council Digital Transformation team to oversee the project.

PLUS 5

Taking a population health management approach to develop a community-based pathway for managing diabetes. Based in a deprived area of Coventry.



Building on the work already done by Sowe Valley PCN during the wave 3 PHM programme.

CORE20

A health justice partnership approach, co-locating social welfare advisers in GP practices in areas of deprivation, helping to free up GP time from non-healthcare issues.



The project will start with one PCN in Coventry and aim to develop to a further Coventry PCN and one in Nuneaton.

PLUS

Improving maternity continuity of care and early access for BAME, vulnerable and deprived groups through VSCE-provided ante and postnatal services including co-produced antenatal pathways for newly arrived families, a transport intervention pilot and culturally appropriate public health messaging.

The project will focus on the Nuneaton & Bedworth area using third sector BAME specialist services.

Health access for refugees programme, based in Coventry but sharing learning with colleagues in Warwickshire.



Taking a personalised care approach to use community assets to support health needs of refugees and asylum seekers

Interventions to address barriers to healthcare experienced by those with respiratory conditions in Lillington, South Warwickshire.

The funding will cover the role of Community Connector to ensure community engagement.

Produce bespoke, locally co-produced health information for cohort discharged from UHCW who live in most deprived 20% areas.



Working with Cognitant to produce information for people from deprived backgrounds who are at highest risk at discharge, with increased readmission and mortality.

CORE20

Funding to underpin prescribing of alternative inhalers (staff training and patient education) for Warwickshire North.



The new inhaler will have a reduced carbon footprint and education will be provided to patients as studies show inhaler technique is incorrect with 50% of patients.
