



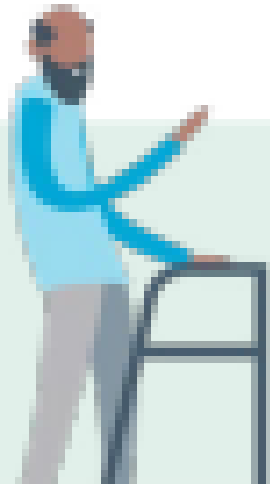
# **Our key priorities for health and care in Coventry and Warwickshire**



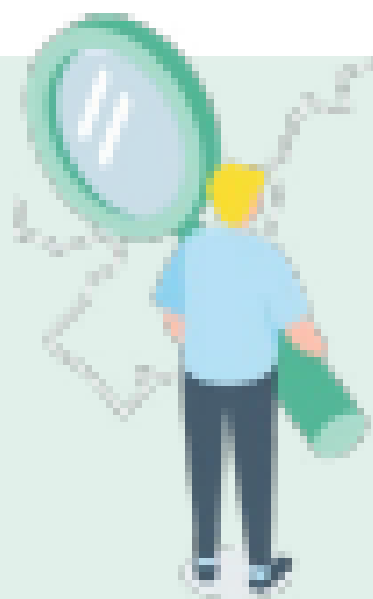
# The challenges for Coventry and Warwickshire Integrated Care System



**The Integrated Care System needs to save money.**



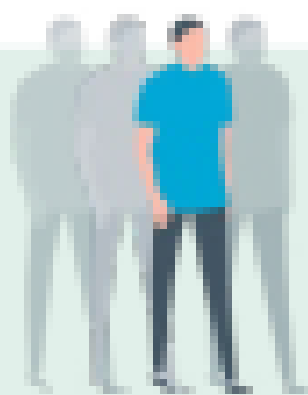
**The number of people are growing. People are living longer with poor health.**

# Our priorities

We have decided three priorities which will improve health in Coventry and Warwickshire.

These priorities were made from things that people have told us they wanted to see.

## Priority 1: Stop people getting ill and make things fairer



We will reduce the unfair differences in people's health. People who find it harder to get help will get extra support to be healthy and well.



People will have support to live a happy and healthy life. They will know what to do to prevent getting ill. There will be support for employment, finances and housing

There will be the best start in life for children and young people.

## Priority 2: Improve access to health and care services. Increase trust and confidence



People will find it easier to use health and care services in Coventry and Warwickshire. This will include helping people with digital skills, so they can make appointments online.



People will be able to get information, support and healthcare when they need it.



People will get better care based on what matters to them.



We will work with other partners like the fire service, the police and voluntary and community groups.



Local communities will be stronger as everyone will work together.

## Priority 3: Tackling problems and challenges in the way we work



There is more need for health and care services. More people have complex needs. There isn't enough money. Staff are worn out after the Covid-19 pandemic. There are higher staff sick levels. There are a lot of staff vacancies.
